

Momentum 2019 - Frequently Ask Questions

What is MOMENTUM?

MOMENTUM is Cornerstone Fellowship's high school winter camp. It's an overnight event hosted at our Livermore Campus on February 22-23, 2019. There will be worship, indoor/outdoor games, ice skating rink activities, a guest speaker and community group sessions!

What is the cost of MOMENTUM (and what does that include)?

Cost is \$99 per student and online registration closes on February 20, 2019. Walk-up registration will be available, but swag and preferred shirt size will depend on availability. The cost includes four (4) meals and snacks beginning with dinner Friday evening; hotel lodging, off campus activity, bus transportation to/from off campus activity and a Momentum t-shirt with swag bag.

Can my student invite friends who do not attend Cornerstone Fellowship?

ALL high school students are welcome to attend MOMENTUM, whether they attend Cornerstone or not.

Is MOMENTUM an overnight event?

Yes, MOMENTUM is an overnight event. We have reservations at local hotels; males and females will be at separate hotels. There will be leader supervision, as well as a security team on duty throughout the entire night.

When and where do I drop off my student?

MOMENTUM check-in is on Friday, February 22, at 5:00pm at our Livermore Campus, 348 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore.

When and where do I pick up my student?

Please pick up your student at 9:30pm on Saturday, February 23, at our Livermore Campus, 348 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore.

I want my student to participate in MOMENTUM, but he/she has a commitment during the event. Can I pick up/drop off my student at any point during the event?

The safety and security of our students is our primary concern and we must maintain an accurate headcount. If you need to pick up or drop off your student at any point during the event, please notify our HS Admin in advance at stephanied@cornerstoneweb.org and let us know the departure & return time(s).

Can Cornerstone accommodate my student's dietary and/or allergy restrictions?

You will have an opportunity to provide details in the registration form. We will have accommodations for special dietary needs that are noted on registration, however, students are welcome to provide their own special dietary meals, if preferred - please let our HSM Admin, Stephanie Doyle (stephanied@cornerstoneweb.org) know ahead of time for any special arrangement(s).

What if my student needs to take prescribed medication overnight?

If your student needs to bring any medication, please complete the medication form attached to the registration form, print it, and bring it to check-in. Any medication must be in its original container stored in a zip-top bag labeled with your student's name and campus to be checked in on Friday night. *Each student will be responsible for seeing a staff/medical representative to take it.*

What should my student pack for MOMENTUM?

What to bring: Medicine (must be in its original container), toiletries, change of clothes, warm jacket (will have some free-time activities outside), Bible, notebook and pen. Optional: sleeping bag and own pillow.

What **NOT** to bring: Drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor), alcohol, tobacco, vape pens, fireworks, firearms or electronic devices, including cell phones.

Can my student bring their cell phone to the event?

We highly encourage students to leave their cell phone (as well as any other electronics) at home while attending the event. Although there is cell reception at church, phones may provide distractions and prohibit students from fully engaging at MOMENTUM.

Please Note: If a student does bring their phone or electronics, they run the risk of it being broken, lost or stolen, and Cornerstone Fellowship is not responsible for any loss/damages to personal belongings.
