



## Trunk-or-Treat Guidelines

Thanks for volunteering to decorate your vehicle for Trunk-or-Treat! We are so excited for this event!

If you are new to Trunk-or-Treat, it is an event where volunteers decorate the trunks of their cars and kids walk by the cars and receive candy at each decorated car. It is a great time for the children to enjoy the evening and not feel scared about trick-or-treating, and it is a great opportunity to introduce families to our church.

### DECORATING YOUR TRUNK

There are lots of creative, family-friendly ways that you can decorate your vehicle. We recommend that you pick a theme for your vehicle and your costume. The less your car looks like a car, the better; and the best car will win a prize! Bring at least 200 individually wrapped pieces of candy, and try to give out only one piece per child so you don't run out early. We will have additional candy on hand if you run out.

**Because so many of our trunk-or-treaters will be preschoolers and toddlers, we ask that participants not use blood, skeletons, bats, witches, ghosts, monsters, gore, occult symbols, etc.**

Here are some suggested themes:

- Disney, Pixar, or other kid-friendly movies
- Circus
- Western
- Space, Sci-Fi
- Medieval
- Race car
- Princess or Superhero
- Decade theme: 50's, 60's, 70's, 80's, 90's etc.
- Bible stories
- Sports
- Camping
- Zoo or Barnyard
- Pirate

Please note that one adult **MUST** be present at each vehicle at all times during the event.

### SAFETY GUIDELINES

For the safety of everyone attending, the following items are not allowed on your vehicle or your costumes:

- Toy weapons- guns, knives, etc.
- Open flames, fireworks, or flammable materials
- Pets or animals
- Alcohol/"adult" beverages

## SCHEDULE

- The cars will park in the Livermore Campus Front Parking Lot (348 N. Canyons Parkway, Livermore). One space will be provided per vehicle.
- You may park your car early if you need to decorate it in the parking lot.
- You may arrive as early as 4:00pm and as late as 5:30pm. You will be directed to a parking space. We will close the lot at 5:30pm.
- We will watch the cars if you want to go to the 5pm service. Please be ready at your cars right after service
- We will open Trunk-or-Treat at 6:30pm.
- You may NOT leave the parking lot until 8:30pm. If the times do not work for you, we would love to have you volunteer in some other capacity.
- Once everyone is cleared from the lot, you may leave.
