

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the cost of MOMENTUM (and what does that include)?

\$119 registration fee per student from 12/15/19 – 2/23/20.

Registration is required and closes on February 23. No walk-in registrations will be processed.

The cost includes (3) meals beginning with breakfast on Friday night; hotel lodging, off campus activity, bus transportation to/from off campus activity, and a Momentum t-shirt.

Can my student invite friends who do not attend Cornerstone Fellowship?

ALL high school students are welcome to attend MOMENTUM, whether they attend Cornerstone or not.

When and where do I drop off my student?

MOMENTUM check-in is on [Friday, February 28, at 5:30pm at our Livermore Campus](#), 348 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore.

Is MOMENTUM an overnight event?

Yes, MOMENTUM is an overnight event. We have reservations at local hotels; males and females will be at separate hotels. There will be leader supervision as well as a security team on duty throughout the entire night.

When and where do I pick up my student?

Please pick up your student at 9:30pm on Saturday, February 29, at our Livermore Campus, 348 North Canyons Parkway, Livermore.

I want my student to participate in MOMENTUM, but he/she has a commitment during the event. Can I pick up/drop off my student at any point during the event?

The safety and security of our students is our primary concern and we must maintain an accurate headcount at all times. If you need to pick up or drop off your student at any point during the event, please notify us in advance of the departure & return times at highschool@cornerstoneweb.org.

Can Cornerstone accommodate my student's dietary and/or allergy restrictions?

You will have an opportunity to provide details in the registration form. We will make every effort to accommodate dietary needs.

What should my student pack for MOMENTUM?

What to bring: Medicine (in its original container), toiletries, change of clothes, jacket, Bible, notebook and pen.

What not to bring: Drugs (unless prescribed by a doctor), alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes/vapes, fireworks, firearms or electronic devices.

Can my student bring their cell phone to MOMENTUM?

We highly encourage students to leave their cell phone (as well as any other electronics) at home while attending MOMENTUM. Although there is cell reception at Cornerstone, phones may provide distractions and prohibit students from fully engaging at MOMENTUM. Please Note: If a student does bring their phone they run the risk of it being broken, lost or stolen.
